Additional day focuses on fellows

Like each year, our fellowship program will welcome up to 200 participants to join the Global Media Forum. Funded by the Federal Foreign Office, this initiative targets media professionals, academics, NGO representatives and other influencers from developing countries, paying for all costs associated with travel and accommodation as well as a full conference pass. In 2019, the fellowship program will also include access to a one day capacity building event for the first time, where fellows will be offered workshops and training in areas on verification, mobile reporting, fund-raising and many more.
